All senior managers, department managers, project managers, supervisors and foreman are responsible and accountable for the health and safety of employees under their supervision. All senior managers, department managers, project managers, supervisors and foreman are responsible to ensure that machinery and equipment are safe and that workers/employees follow established safe work practices and procedures.
